3. Pursuant to regulation 34 of the Regulations, we are pleased to award TUV SUD PSB Pte. Ltd. accreditation as an accredited external auditor to conduct independent verification of greenhouse gas emissions under the CPA and the Regulations for the following complex sectors with effect from 12 Feb 2020 (the "Effective Date").

Sector 1	Refining of oil and gas, and large scale manufacture of chemical products
Sector 2	Manufacture (other than large scale manufacture) of chemical products

4. The accreditation is valid till 27 Aug 2022 (please refer to our earlier approval letter dated 27 Aug 2019), and is subject to the applicable provisions in the CPA and Regulations. For the purpose of reassessment for renewal, you are required to reapply to NEA to extend the accreditation at least 90 days prior to the expiry of the current accreditation.
