## Hygiene rules for examination participants at the TÜV SÜD Academy

Exceptional situations call for exceptional measures – even when taking an examination. In order to protect all our customers and examiners/invigilators, the following rules and measures must be observed when taking an examination.

- The legally required minimum distance or a minimum distance of 1.5 m, whichever is the greater, must be maintained between persons (e.g. upon entering or in communal areas). The seats in the examination rooms have been laid out at this minimum distance.
- If the minimum distance cannot be maintained, a face covering must be worn. Please bring your own face covering with you.
- Wash your hands regularly with soap for a minimum of 20 seconds. Also use the sanitizer provided.
- Refrain from shaking hands with, hugging or touching others.
- Remember cough and sneeze etiquette (use disposable tissues, cough and sneeze into your elbow).
- Do not touch your face.
- Observe any site-specific signs in the room, as well as all currently applicable legal regulations and specific guidelines associated with COVID-19, such as location- or sector-specific regulations. Failure to comply could result in your exclusion from the examination.

Please note that you must not attend the examination and must de-register if you

- have come into contact with a person infected with COVID-19 in the 14 days before the examination,
- are exhibiting symptoms of COVID-19,
- are exhibiting mild cold symptoms that could be considered suspicious.

Only by working together can we overcome this exceptional situation. Please support us by complying with these rules.
