We are looking forward to welcoming everyone to Aberdeen for the Global Flow Measurement Workshop. ### Venue

The Global Flow Measurement Workshop and Gala Dinner will take place on the first floor of P&J Live, East Burn Road, Aberdeen, AB21 9FX.

The venue is located 1.5 miles from Aberdeen International Airport and has two on-site hotels within the event campus - Hilton Aberdeen TECA and Aloft Aberdeen TECA.

For delegates arriving into Aberdeen airport wishing to travel by public transport, [Stagecoach Jet Service 727](#) departs from [Aberdeen Airport](#), stopping at [P&J Live \(TECA\)](#) and onwards to [Aberdeen Union Square Bus Station](#). The service operates 24 hours a day at a frequency of up to every 15 minutes. You can purchase your ticket from the bus driver on the day of travel. For delegates staying offsite, P&J Live can be accessed by bus (727 above), train, taxi and road. Extensive bicycle parking is available in both the surface and Sub-T car parks free of charge.

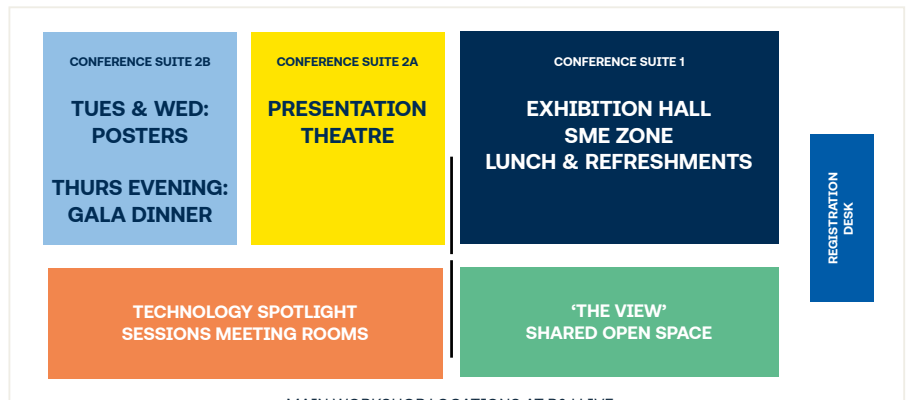

## Registration and Enquiries

The registration desk is situated on the first floor of the lobby at the top of the escalator for the duration of the event.

Delegates should present their e-ticket with QR code on arrival in exchange for their pass which they need to retain for the duration of the event.



## Exhibition
