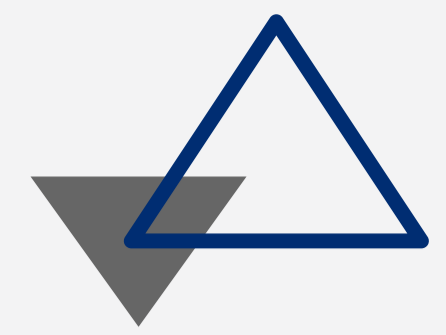


Introduction to TISAX



Trusted Information Security Assessment Exchange (TISAX) standardizes the cybersecurity criteria from automakers. TISAX was originally developed through Verband der Automobilindustrie (VDA), and is accredited through the European Network Exchange (ENX).

You will need to work with your partner(s) to understand the required objectives for your TISAX Label (Label is a term that essentially means certification). The minimum requirement is “Information with High Protection Needs.” However, you may choose to also add applicable objectives, or ones you foresee expansion into, to your assessment. Before choosing Assessment Objectives or Levels, it is highly recommended to work with your OEM partner(s) to help select the correct ones. If you are unable to work with your partner(s) or you are being proactive in obtaining your labels, you can contact ENX or view the information available to you in section 4.3 of the TISAX Participant Handbook.

Assessment Objectives

1 Information with High Protection Needs

You may derive the protection needs as high from the document classification of your partner.

2 Information with Very High Protection Needs

You may derive the protection needs as high from the document classification of your partner.

3 Data Protection

If you handle personal data as a processor according to article 28 of the GDPR, you probably need to select this objective.

4 Data Protection with Special Categories of Personal Data

If you handle special categories of personal data (like health or religion) as a processor according to article 28 of the GDPR, then you probably need to select this objective.

5 Protection of Prototype Parts and Components of Personal Data

For all companies that manufacture, store or use customer-provided components or parts classified as requiring protection at their own locations.

6 Protection of Prototype Vehicles

For all companies that manufacture, store or use customer-provided vehicles classified as requiring protection at their own locations.

7 Handling of Test Vehicles

For all companies that conduct tests and test drives (e.g. test drives on public roads or test tracks) with customer-provided vehicles classified as requiring protection.

8 Protection of Prototypes During Events and Film or Photo Shootings

For all companies that conduct presentations or events (e.g. market research, events, marketing events) and film and photo shootings with customer-provided vehicles, components or parts classified as requiring protection.
