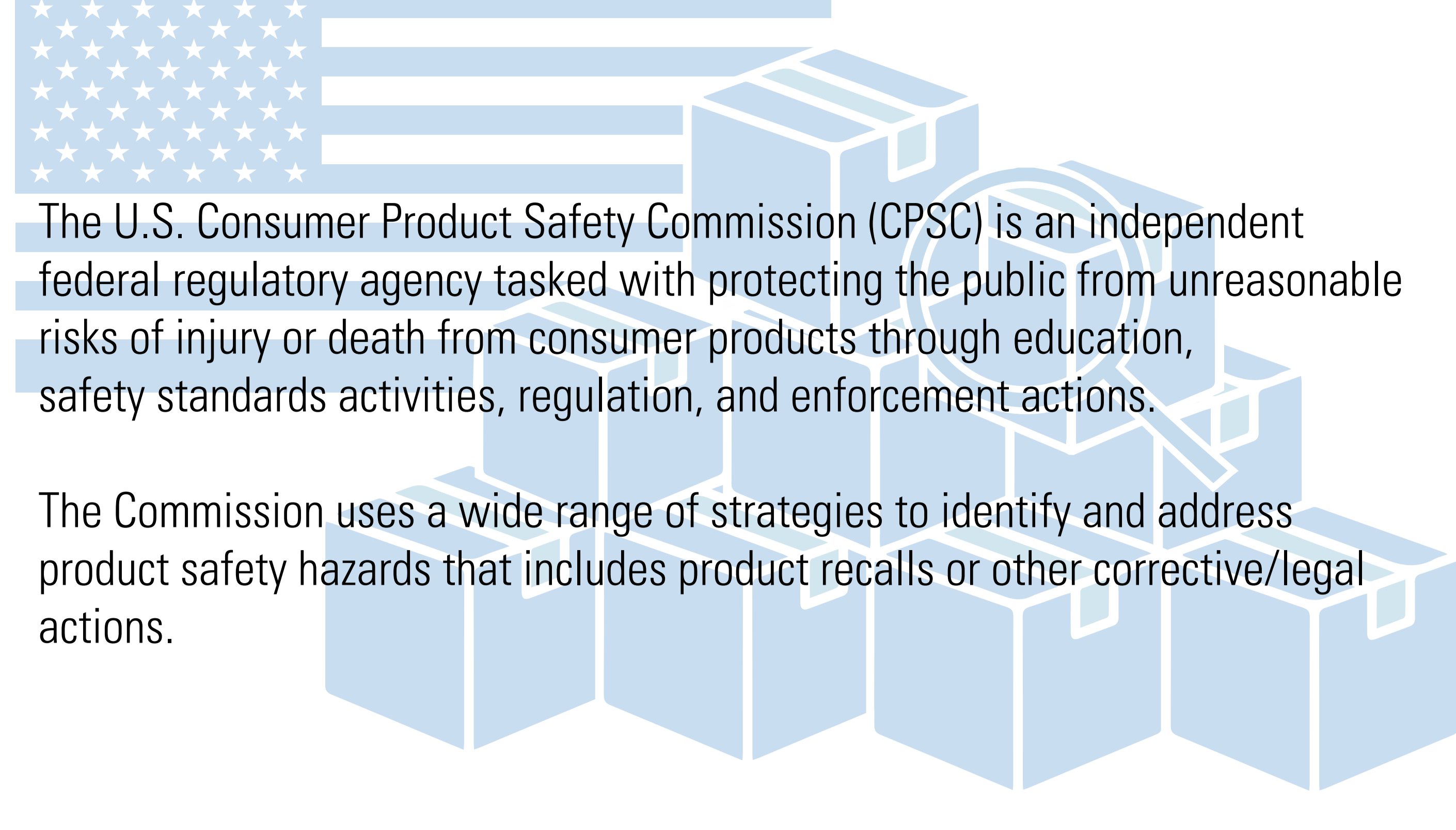


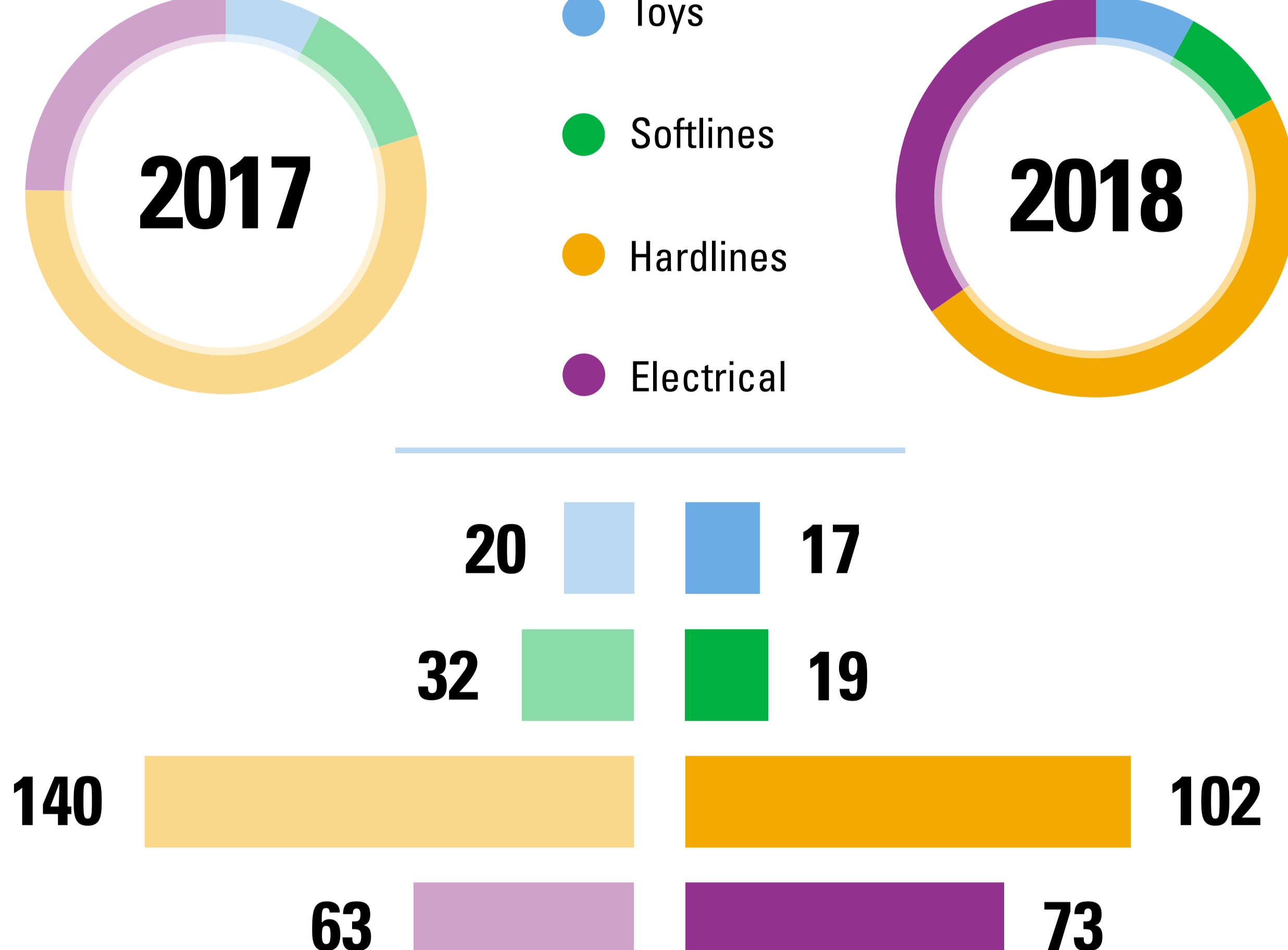
2018 CPSC PRODUCT RECALL STATISTICS SUMMARY



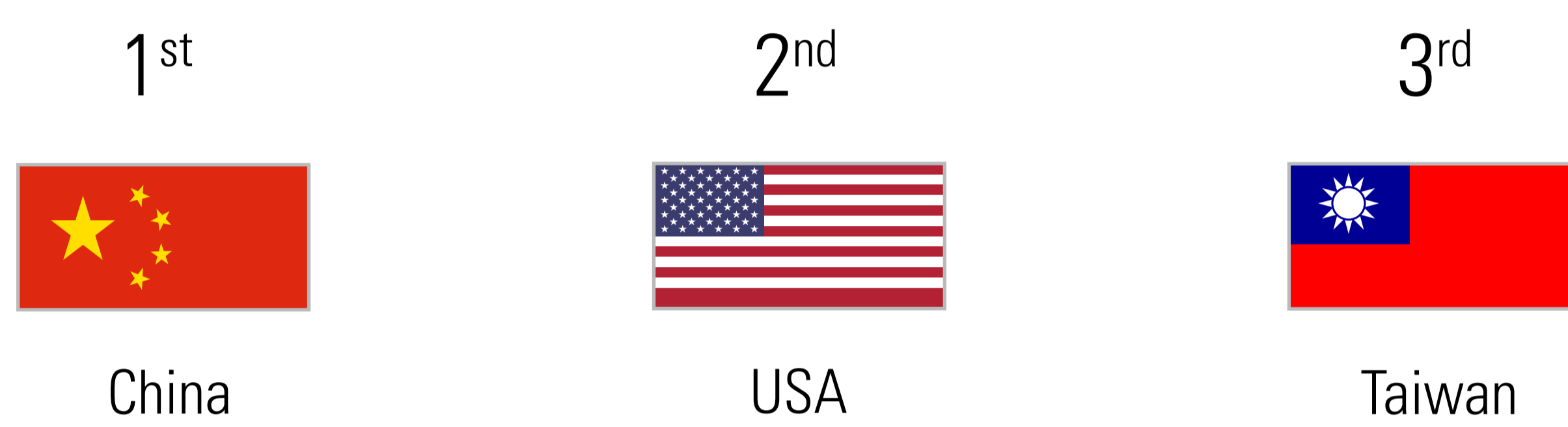
The U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission (CPSC) is an independent federal regulatory agency tasked with protecting the public from unreasonable risks of injury or death from consumer products through education, safety standards activities, regulation, and enforcement actions.

The Commission uses a wide range of strategies to identify and address product safety hazards that includes product recalls or other corrective/legal actions.

Product Recall Comparisons of :



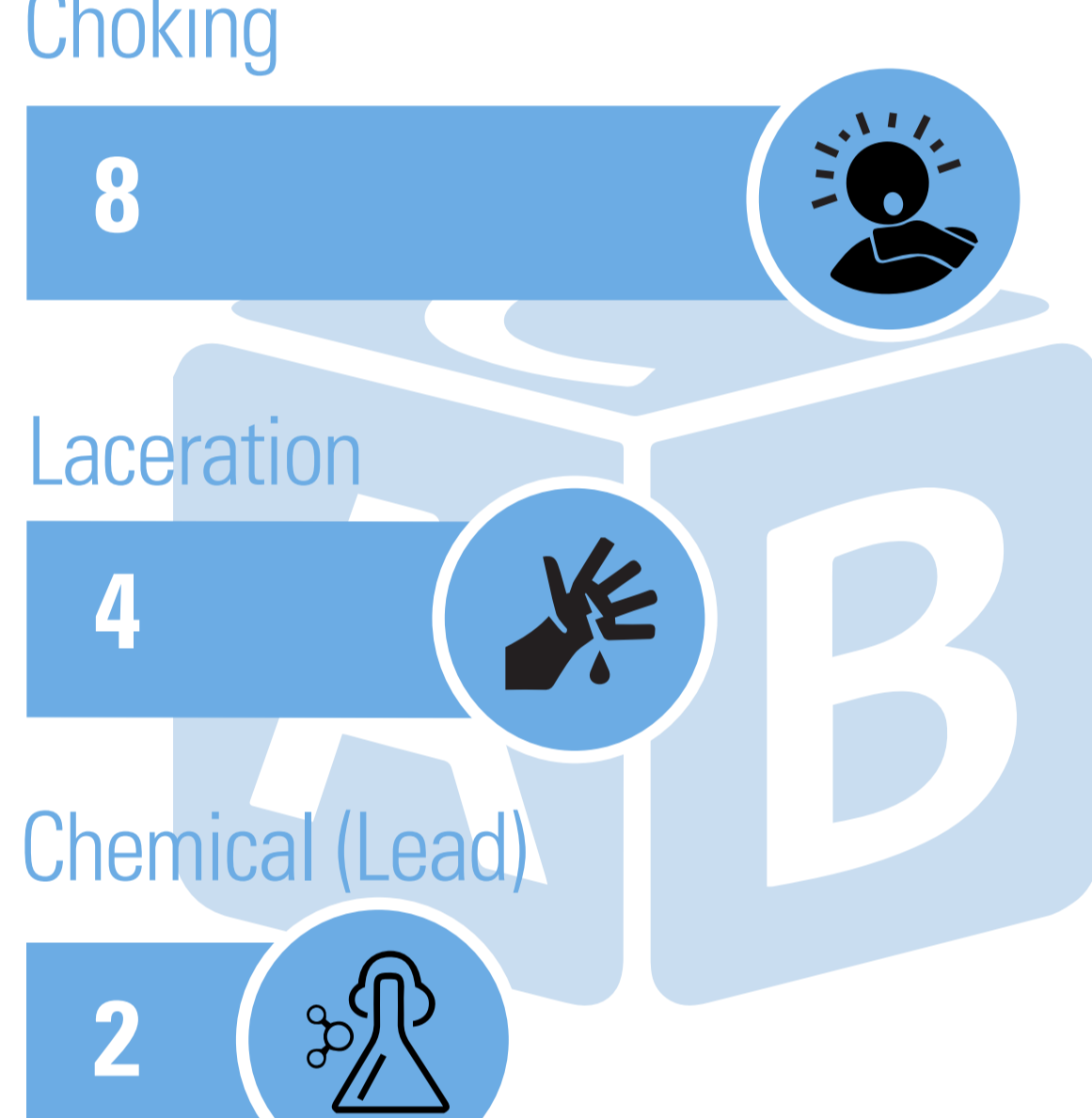
Top 3 Manufacturing Countries - Products Recalled



Top Three Risks for Toys

The number of recall cases for Toys has decreased by 15% in 2018 over 2017.

Choking is the top risk for Toys due to presence of small parts in both years.



Top Three Risks for Softlines

The number of recall cases for Softline products decreased by 41% in 2018 over 2017.

Recall cases due to Flammability reduced noticeably.

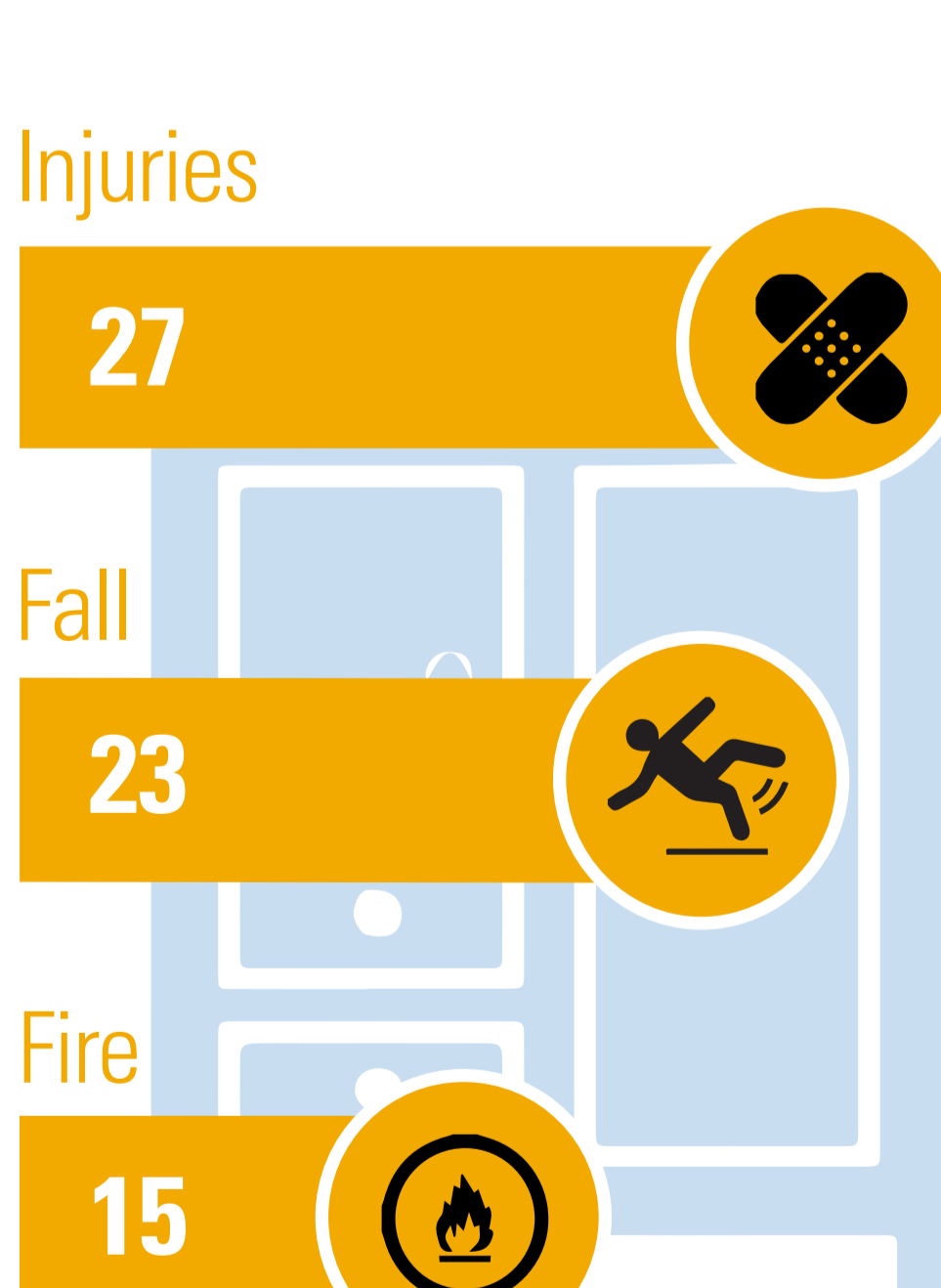
Choking hazards remain as the topmost risk for Softlines in 2018.

Top Three Risks for Hardlines

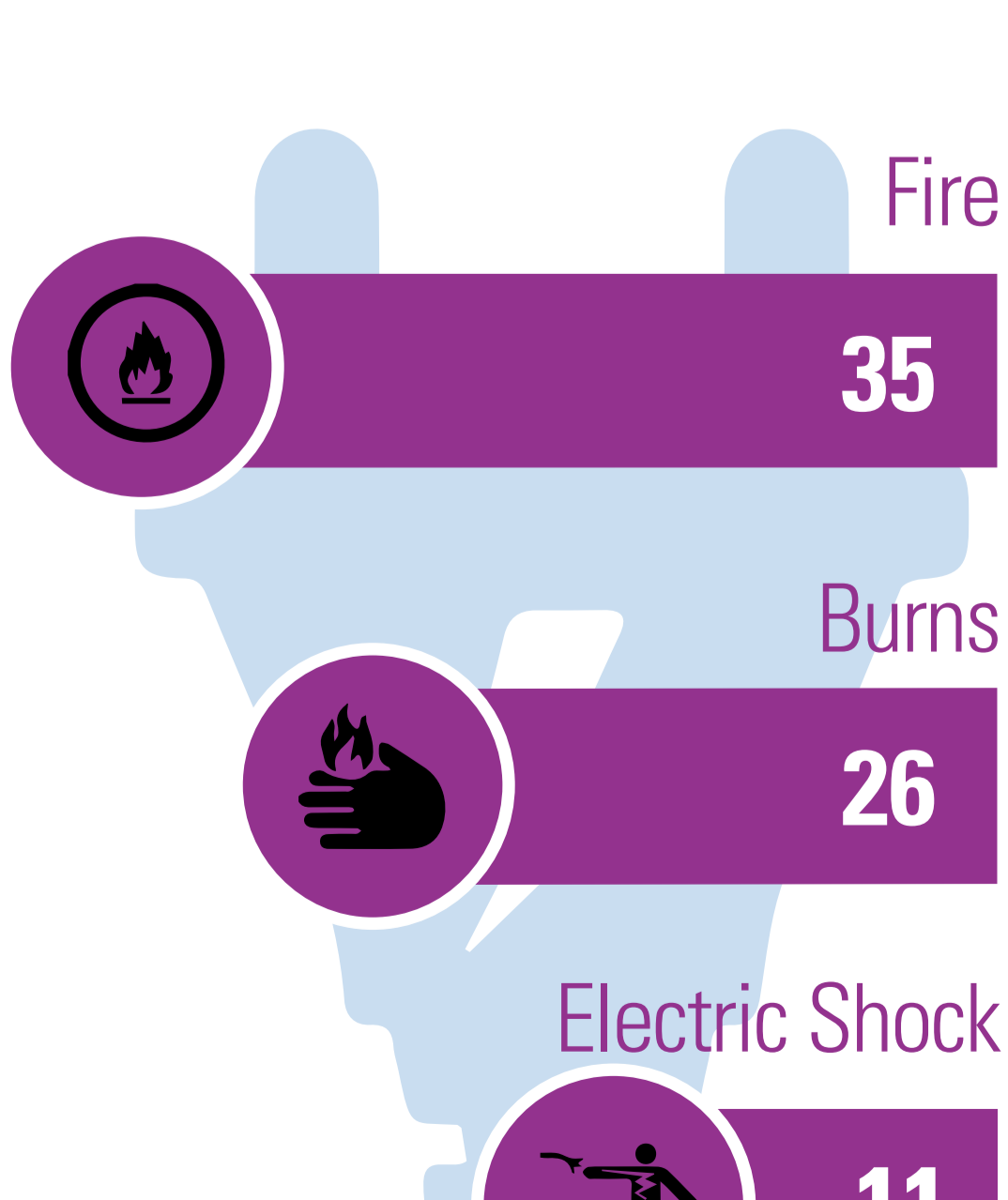
In contrast to 2017, there is a 27% drop in total number of recalls for hardlines products in 2018.

Fall hazard remains among the top risks in both years.

Seating furniture and bicycle mechanical issues respectively, constitute the top two recalls related to fall hazards in both years.



Top Three Risks for EnE



There has been a 16% increase in the total number of recalls for 2018 over 2017.

Fire hazard remains top risk in both years.

Bad insulation of wirings and over-heating leads to risk of fire.
